From The Pastor's Desk

"A SECOND CHANCE"

In Luke 22, when Jesus is sitting with his disciples during the last supper, he begins to tell his them that one of them is going to betray him. His disciples begin to argue about which one it could be...and even about who among them was the greatest? Imagine that? Then Jesus tells Peter that he has prayed for him specifically, and that his faith wouldn't fail. Peter's response is pretty predictable. He says in vs. 33-34, "Lord, I am ready to go to prison with you, and even to die with you. "34 But Jesus said, "Peter, let me tell you something. Before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me." Can you imagine the heartbreak Peter is feeling as those words are coming out of Jesus' mouth? Can you imagine the heartbreak that Peter feels even as the words of denial are leaving his mouth each of the three times? I think we all have done that. We all have heard words leave our mouth that we can't believe we are saying and soon regret. But Peter, he has denied Jesus three times, and the last glimpse he has of Jesus before His crucifixion is in the glow of the fire in the high priest's courtyard, where he actually made eye contact with Jesus. And then he went out and wept bitterly. How does your conscience live with that?

What kind of look do you think Jesus gave Peter when their eyes met? Do you think it was one of those I-told-you-so looks? Do you think it was one of scorn, as if to say, "How could you betray Me?" I don't think it was either one. I think it was a look of love, a look of compassion that said, "I still love you, Peter." And I believe that is why Peter went out and wept bitterly. He had failed the Lord so miserably. He probably thought there was no hope for him.

But then a message went out from the empty tomb that Jesus had risen, followed by these instructions found in Mark 16: 7, "Go, tell His disciples—and Peter. . . ." It was not, "Go tell the disciples, including Peter, James, and John. . . ." It was just Peter, because Peter needed a special word of encouragement...a second chance.

Jump ahead to John 21. Jesus is standing on the beach with a charcoal fire going. The disciples realize that it is Jesus standing there and make their way to him from the Sea. The smell of that charcoal fire would have taken Peter back to that night of denial. Then Jesus asks Peter...three times...do you love me? Each time Peter responds, "you know I love you." Jesus then tells Peter to feed his lambs, care for my sheep, and feed my sheep. Jesus wanted Peter to know that the promise made to him long ago in Matthew 16 that, "upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it. 19 And I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven. Whatever you forbid on earth will be forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit on earth will be permitted in heaven," still holds true. Peter was given a second chance. For each time that he denied, he was forgiven! Can you imagine the relief?

Do you need encouragement during this Lenten Season? Maybe you have fallen short. You didn't plan on it, but it happened. And like Peter, maybe you ended up with the wrong people in the wrong place at the wrong time, ultimately doing the wrong thing.

God sent Jesus to die on the cross for times just such as this! God gave Peter a second chance to help build His church and He will do the same for you!
