From The Pastor's Desk

"SEALED ORDERS"

"Sealed Orders" is defined as orders that are not to be opened before a specified time. This term is used mainly during times of war so that the enemy won't know what the plan is for a particular group of soldiers. A unit is never given their next objective until they have completed their prior assignment.

During the course of our lives, we move from "sealed order" to "sealed order." Sometimes we have more than one task before us, but we usually don't have two major events going on at the same time...if we do...it limits our ability to accomplish them both with our full focus and best effort.

In our Christian lives we often ask the question, "Why won't God reveal to me the next "sealed order?" God answers us by reminding us that we already know a lot of things that He wants us to do, but we aren't doing them? God is not obligated to give us step 2 when we have never completed step 1. So let's look at some of the basics. Are you reading your Bible on a daily basis? Are you involved in any small groups or Bible studies? Are you tithing? Are you praying? Are you currently attending church on a regular basis? And if you are, have you made the commitment to join that church and become an active member? These are just a few of the areas of life that we all need to be participating in on a regular basis as followers of Jesus Christ! Ecclesiastes 5: 4 says, "When you make a promise to God, don't delay in following through, for God takes no pleasure in fools." Are you going to make it to the end of another week, or another year, without doing what God has already told you to do?

Don't delay. Do what you already know to do?
